Each fall, Red Ribbon Week is celebrated across America to promote the importance of a healthy, drug-free lifestyle among our youth. The outstanding student Red Ribbon leaders are selected by their local school administration as individuals who exemplify the 6 pillars of Character promoted by the national Character Counts initiative and the Drug Education Council. These include the qualities of trustworthiness, respect, responsibility, fairness, caring, and citizenship. Each honoree will lead campus-wide substance abuse prevention activities during Red Ribbon Week and participate in a community service project that the student leader organizes.

Your school's Red Ribbon Sponsor/Coordinator should select a student to represent your school at the Annual Superintendents' Red Ribbon Leadership Awards. **The Red Ribbon Sponsor should register your school's student representative online at www.drugeducation.org.** You should register your student no later than **Friday, September 13th**. Late registration may result in your student's name not being on the program or their certificate not being signed by their Superintendent.
